

# Nationwide JR Route Map

## Transport services and routes covered by this pass

- Railways:** JR lines throughout Japan, including Shinkansen "bullet trains" (except for "NOZOMI" and "MIZUHO" services), limited express trains, express trains and local trains. ★  
 Tokyo Monorail  
 Aomori Railway line between Hachinohe and Aomori, Aomori and Noheji, or Hachinohe and Noheji (valid only for use on local trains)  
 IR Ishikawa Railway line between Kanazawa and Tsubata Ainokaze Toyama Railway line between Toyama and Takaoka (valid only for use on local trains)  
 Hapi-Line Fukui between Echizen-Hanandō and Fukui (valid only for use on local trains)  
 (On Aomori, IR Ishikawa, Ainokaze Toyama Railways, and Hapi-Line Fukui, valid only for travel extending through the indicated segments without stopover)
- Buses:** JR Bus services (except for expressway buses and some local services).
- Ferry:** JR Miyajima ferry \* You will be required to additionally pay a Miyajima visitor tax (100 yen) upon your visit.

The stations in red in the map have JAPAN RAIL PASS exchange offices. (as of April 2026)

## Transport services and routes NOT covered by this pass

This pass is not valid for "NOZOMI" and "MIZUHO" services (both reserved and non-reserved) on the Tōkaidō, Sanyō, and Kyūshū Shinkansen lines. ★

## Trains and services requiring additional basic fares and charges

Travel on JR Group trains that connect directly with non-JR Group railways will require additional payment of basic fares and charges for the sections operated by the other company. Please pay either on the train or at a station on the line of the company concerned. (The map below shows the main applicable train lines. Additional payment may also be required on non-regular services in addition to these.) There are also some JR trains that connect directly with subway lines, etc. not shown in the map requiring additional fares and charges for the sections of those lines.


